The software includes interactive educational information (text, slide shows, videos) about the concept of recovery; tools to create, store, and update a personal recovery plan; tools to support self-monitoring of progress and warning signs; and chat rooms and groups to facilitate community discussions. An easy-to-use online environment enables recovery plan creation and monitoring, social networking, and personal online coaching from a certified peer specialist.

DBSA President Allen Doederlein says, "We are delighted to join forces with InfoMC to make this tool available to a broad user base. InfoMC is an organization with a real commitment to the health and wellbeing of their clients and the individuals they serve.
